- As a quick reference they need the following with most requiring a booster after the age of 4: (4) Dtap; (3) Polio; (2) MMR; (2) Varicella; series of 3—Hep B., Pneumococcal and Hib are not required after age of 5. They are required for pre-school along with a physical every two years. See Nurse Dana at South School for more specific information for pre-school.

2ND Meningitis (unless your child did not receive the 1st booster until after age 16, then just 1 one is required.

- **Note on Varicella**—eventually all grade levels will have to show proof of having received 2 doses. This year (2017-2018) grades requiring 2 doses will be: K, 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12. It will continue to add each year.
- **Note on** Meningitis—This year (2017-2018) 6th, 7th, and 8th grades need 1 dose; 12th grade needs 2 doses or 1 after their 16th birthday.
