## **Our Theme will be Roads and Transportation**

1. Each classroom will have a daily discussion book for character education.
2. Each week a student will get to wear a construction vest to show they display the trait of the month.
3. A monthly book will be read at the beginning of the month– see above.
4. A monthly speaker will be asked by each grade level to talk about their career and how the character trait of the month is essential to do their job.
5. Street Signs will be displayed in the hallway and the big bulletin board will be utilized for student interest.
6. The Big Bulletin Board will have Grade Level Roads. Each teacher will try to reach the end of the road character trait monthly. To reach your weekly goal, we will track tardies and unexcused absences, principal reports, recess referrals and bus referrals.
7. Classroom: Each student will have a car provided by the office. The students will try to earn a monthly sticker. This will be up to you - by not being on red at the end of the day, bringing back homework, or whatever you want.
8. At the end of the year, the classroom from each grade level that reached the most goals will get a fun activity!
